Activity: Student Presentations: Favourite Activity
Time: 2+ hours
Materials: My Favourite Sport; Canadian Concepts 4 (2nd ed. p.50)

Learning Outcomes:

Learners will be able to:

- Describe their favourite activity or sport.
- Give details about when, where, why s/he likes this activity.

Suggested Approach:

- Have learners choose an activity or sport that they enjoy. Refer to Canadian Concepts 4 p. 50 and use the questions given, or adapt the questions to fit the level of your class.
- Level 2 classes might just answer the questions in Part A for the presentation – What is the sport? Do you play it yourself? Where do you play it? How often do you play it?
- Level 3 classes can continue with questions from Part B and C. E.g. What special equipment do you need? What are the rules? (see note below). What benefits do you get from this sport? Are there any risks? etc.

Note: Be aware at the outset that explaining the rules of sports and games can be **complicated** in one's first language, let alone in a second language! Pictures and diagrams can help a lot.
