Job Description

The First Steps Program is an integrated, partnership program that promotes awareness of Early Childhood Development, settlement resources related to parenting and other related resources among isolated refugee families living in Surrey/Delta/White Rock areas.

The Multicultural ECD Outreach Worker (Arabic) will act as a Key Worker for families by gathering information relevant to the client's problems, needs, and risks by interviewing, observing behaviour, meeting with caregivers and service providers and using a variety of inventories, checklists and questionnaires. He/she will develop and implement a service plan which may include referrals, home visits, integration visits or other, within program guidelines. He/she will also provide ongoing support for daily group programs, literacy and education activities, field trips, and other related activities.

The successful candidate will have professional experience in a client service role in the community and settlement sectors with excellent knowledge of the barriers facing refugee and immigrant communities. He/she will have a proven ability to lead group activities for parents and young children. Knowledge of resources and programs available for families with children 0-6 years old in Surrey/Delta/White Rock is an asset. This position requires oral and written fluency in Arabic. Regular weekend work is required. This position is 28 temporary hours, finishing June 30 2016.
