Growing Together is an infant toddler childcare program attached to a young parent education program in Surrey. We offer licensed childcare and parenting support in collaboration with the Surrey School District.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend to the children's physical, social, emotional and cognitive needs.
- Plan, carry out, and evaluate developmentally appropriate activities and experiences for the children.
- Help parents increase their knowledge of child development and parenting skills through role modeling and teachable moments.
- Provide a supportive and nurturing relationship with the parents and extended family of the child in your care.
- Complete daily observations, developmental checklists and written reports when required. Conduct parent/teacher interviews (minimum two times a year). Liaise with other professionals as necessary.
- Ensure a healthy and safe environment. Maintain health records and administers first aid and medication as required. Observe and remove potential hazards. Report all incidents of suspected child abuse to the supervisory position and follow organization's procedures and government legislation.

- Experience working with adolescents.
