
Position Title: Contract Youth Worker/Facilitator (Girls Group Program)

Summary

NSMS is seeking an experienced, dynamic female youth worker to plan and co-deliver the Girls Group program for Grade 8-12's on a contract basis. Under the direction of the Program Manager, the Youth Worker/Facilitator will be responsible for working within a team approach with the Youth Team Leader/Facilitator to create curriculum for the program, deliver/facilitate, and evaluate the program.

The program will consist of 7 sessions through March 14-17 & March 21-23. Each session will be held from 10am to 12pm at North Shore Multicultural Society (NSMS).

Each day will include 4 working hours, including prep time, program time, clean up and dealing with any specific needs. There will be an additional 2 hours allocated for meeting time, for a total of 30 hours. The program will include activities designed to foster confidence building, self-reflection and connection amongst participants, and support the integration process of immigrant girls.

- Experience in finding methods to overcome immigrant youth barriers/problem solving

- Experience in one-on-one youth support an asset
