The Multicultural ECD Outreach Worker (Swahili/Tigrinya) will act as a Key Worker for families by gathering information relevant to the clients' problems, needs, and risks by interviewing, observing behavior, meeting with caregivers and service providers and using a variety of inventories, checklists and questionnaires. He/she will develop and implement a service plan which may include referrals, home visits, integration visits or other, within program guidelines. He/she will also provide ongoing support for daily group programs, literacy and education activities, field trips, and other related activities.

The successful candidate will have professional experience in a client service role in the community and settlement sectors with excellent knowledge of the barriers facing refugee and immigrant communities. He/she will have a proven ability to lead group activities for parents and young children. Knowledge of resources and programs available for families with children 0-6 years old in Surrey/Delta/White Rock is an asset. This position requires oral and written fluency in Swahili/Tigrinya as well as proven ability to work well in a diverse team environment.
