Job Summary:

The One Line Referral (OLR) program is focused on community support, accessibility, and inclusiveness for individuals unable to access mainstream programs due to ineligibility or other various barriers. The position of the OLR Resource Support Worker is to support community members with accessing unique resources based on situational needs. The OLR Resource Support Worker works alongside Archway Programs and numerous community programs to provide community members with resources and support one-on-one. Services are provided in both English and Punjabi.

Your Role:

Archway's OLR Resource Support Worker with the One Line Referral Program contributes by:

- Acting as a single point of contact for members of the public to obtain information on social services in the community to meet their needs.
- Providing information and referrals for services, including but not limited to, immigrant and
 refugee services, legal advocacy programs, support with tenancy, youth services, senior services,
 support for families and young children, mental health, substance use and counselling services,
 programs for persons with disabilities, and domestic violence and abuse counselling.
- Understanding that clients should not be turned away without resources or information.
- Assessing client needs and potential risks so the individual can access appropriate resources and meet their goals.
- Providing support and direction to individuals experiencing complex barriers.
- Providing resources and referrals to programs that support individuals and their social, emotional, mental and physical health and overall well being.
- Conferring with clients with regard to unusual or problematic issues they are experiencing.

This position is a great fit for someone who has great listening and communication skills, can quickly assess a situation to provide guidance and support, and can manage crisis and conflict situations and respond accordingly.

- Knowledge of age-appropriate group processes and rapport/relationship building techniques.
- Ability to work within high level crisis and conflict situations and de-escalate.
- Ability to pay close attention to clients' needs, analyze and interpret those needs, and respond appropriately.
- The ability to have a personal vehicle to use for program-related driving, and to be insured according to Archway policy 3.36.
- A satisfactory Criminal Records Check is a condition of employment.
