

**POSITION:** Childcare Assistant Volunteer

**PURPOSE:** To assist the ECE teacher in charge of the children's program in the day-to-day activities of

the class.

**COMMITMENT:** Minimum three hours a week for a minimum of six months

**SUPERVISOR:** This position reports directly to the Childcare program teacher and indirectly to the

Coordinator of Volunteers.

**DUTIES:** 

Help set up the equipment and supplies for the day

• Help greet the children and encourage them to choose activities that interest them

Assist with the activities around the room as required

Help prepare snacks and interact with the children at snack time

Help with outdoor activities

Assist with cleaning up and storing equipment

• Share any special skills or interests with the group

Assist with the special events such as parties or field trips

• Attend and participate in Team Meetings (optional)

Participate in workshops hosted by PIRS(optional)

• Participate in the evaluation of the program

## **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- A warm, patient attitude towards children
- An interest in child development
- An interest in families of various ethnic backgrounds and cultures
- An understanding and respect for varying childrearing practices
- A sensitivity to the needs and concerns of immigrant families
- Reliability
- Willingness to commit to 3 hours per week for at least 6 months
- The physical ability to work with young children
