- Two (2) years recent related experience in suicide prevention/treatment required. A
 combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Excellent oral/written communications and computer skills.
- Satisfactory criminal records check.
- A reliable vehicle is necessary.
- A second language and First Aid training are considered assets.

Job Skills and Abilities:

- Primary responsibilities will be to provide suicide risk assessment/intervention and short-term counselling for children and youth in Surrey and Langley.
- Facilitation of community education and consultation.
- Is well organized and capable of working independently as well as within a larger team.
- Has proven skills in building and maintaining relationships with community partners.
- Crisis Line experience an asset.
