**Position Title:** Contract Youth Worker/Facilitator (Explore North Shore Program)

## Summary

NSMS is seeking an experienced, dynamic youth worker to plan and co-deliver the Explore North Shore program for Grade 8-12 newcomer youth on a contract basis. Under the direction of the Program Manager, the Youth Worker/Facilitator will be responsible for working within a team approach to plan/deliver/facilitate, and evaluate the program. The program will consist of 3 sessions (March 18, 19, 20, 2019) from 10am – 3:30pm at the North Shore Multicultural Society (NSMS).

Each day will include 7 working hours, including prep time, program time, clean up and dealing with any specific needs. There will be an additional 4 hours allocated for meeting/planning time, for a total of 25 hours. The program will include field trips and related activities designed to foster confidence building and connection amongst participants, and to provide opportunities for youth to access and experience using youth-oriented/community centres and facilities.

## Qualifications:

- Degree, diploma, or certificate in community development, youth leadership, counselling or education, and/or an appropriate combination of experience and training
- Experience and/or training in facilitation of youth groups, with demonstrated experience/and strong skills in youth engagement strategies
- Experience in working with immigrant and refugee youth, specifically in the areas of settlement
- Good working knowledge of immigrant youth barriers and challenges, social justice issues, diversity and anti-racism
- Must have a valid First Aid Certificate
- Demonstrated ability to adapt to the learning needs of English language learners
- Excellent interpersonal-communication skills, experienced in conflict resolution
- Experience in finding methods to overcome immigrant youth barriers/problem solving
- Experience in one-on-one youth support an asset
- Second language (Farsi/Mandarin/Cantonese an asset)
- Demonstrated experience working effectively as a co-facilitator
- Demonstrated ability to work with key stakeholders including the supervisor, NSMS colleagues, participants, parents, and funders
