PROGRAM SERVICES

The Career Paths services include:

- Personalized career coaching and action planning
- Reimbursements for some of the costs related to the registration process
- Job search support and labour market information
- Workshops to help you prepare for language proficiency and licensing assessments

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

The Career Paths program eligibility criteria include:

- Permanent resident of Canada for less than 5 years, and not be a Canadian citizen
- High intermediate to advanced level of English
- At least 1 year of experience in your field (up to age 31) or 3 years of experience (31 years+)
- Not receiving Income Assistance, and cannot have received Employment Insurance in the past 5 years (exception: CERB)
