## **HOUSE RULES**

#### **EMERGENCY**

If there is an emergency, please use the telephone or cellphone and dial "911". Tell the operator your exact location and whether you need **police**, **fire** or **ambulance**. **PLEASE KEEP SAFE AT ALL TIMES**.

#### **SAFETY**

Use caution when opening the door to strangers. Check with us if someone you are not expecting comes to our home.

## **FOOTWEAR**

**Please remove your shoes** when entering the house. You can keep slidders at the entrance for you to wear as soon as you enter the house. Please, do not wear outside shoes inside our home.

#### YOUR AREA

We expect you to keep your area of our home tidy and well maintained. Please make sure to check that windows are closed and doors are locked when you leave the house. Personal electronics such as hair tools should be unplugged and fans or heaters turned off when you are not using them to conserve energy.

We will provide you with some cleaning supplies at first, as well as some instructions, and we are always happy to answer questions.















### **LAUNDRY**

You will have access to a personal laundry basket. Please use it for your dirty laundry. We can arrange a rotating laundry schedule so everyone can have access to the laundry equipment. We can provide detergent for the first few weeks. We will teach you how the appliances work and expect you to follow them and keep the area clean.

## SHOWERS, BATHS, AND WASHROOMS

- Please leave the washroom clean when you are done showering or using the toilet.
- Remove all hair and leftover soap, if necessary, off the floor, counters and bathtub and leave the bathtub and sink clean and rinsed.
- Kindly limit your time in the shower to 12-20 minutes to allow others to use it. Please turn on the fan or open the window to air out the bathroom after you are done.
- We provide soap, toilet paper, face towels and body towels. All other toiletries, if needed, will be your responsibility.
- Keep the bathroom door open when not in use.
- Please be respectful to quiet time and use the shower during reasonable morning or evening schedules (between 7 am and 9:30 pm) whenever possible.

### **KITCHEN**

Dishes, cups, cutlery and pots will be supplied to you. Please clear away any of the dishes you use and clean up after yourself in the kitchen. We will teach you how to use all the appliances during the first few weeks of your stay.

#### **QUIET TIME**

Please respect our quiet time from 9:30 pm to 6:30 am. Kindly limit loud conversations, showers, music, movies or cooking after quiet time. We ask you to respect the quiet time as much as possible.
