Reporting Unsafe Conditions at Work

WHAT TO REPORT

- Unsafe or harmful conditions or actions that could cause injury
- Spills, leaks, or wet floors
- Blocked exits or walkways
- Damaged, frayed, or overheated electrical cords
- Broken or malfunctioning equipment
- Clutter, tripping hazards, and unstable stacks of boxes
- Any situation that “doesn’t look right” or could lead to harm



WHY REPORTING MATTERS

- Prevents injuries and accidents
- Protects coworkers and visitors
- Ensures issues are addressed quickly by the right people
- Creates a culture where safety is shared and valued



HOW TO REPORT

- Report unsafe or harmful conditions as soon as possible to your supervisor or employer.
- The supervisor or employer must investigate and correct the issue without delay.
